3. Minutes

Minutes of the previous Parish Council meeting were approved, and then signed by the Chairman as a true record.

4. Matters to discuss/report

- a) Allotments – apologies from SP but he did leave a new allotment plot layout and some payments for this year. To discuss at next meeting.
- b) Playpark – finally got the go ahead. Measuring up for fencing, if quotes ok will go ahead and hopefully start before the summer. The parish council will donate some funding towards this project. Also Tony Markley said we could possibly apply for some funding from Allerdale.
- c) Website Update – up and running holmeabbeypc.org.uk. Quite basic version but LH meeting again with CALC how to upload all future documents and update the website. Various ideas of what to put on the website so discuss at next meeting.
- d) Clerks Payscale – Justification that Clerk doing more work now, due to forthcoming projects, which has incurred a proportionate increase in clerk's salary. BB proposed a salary increase, MM seconded it.
- e) D-fib update – BB looked into this, the Pad 500P is the best type because it has a success rate of 7/10 people being resuscitated. Also the Heartsafe Digital Combination Lock Cabinet. Maintenance free for the first year, and then £49 thereafter. The ideal place would of course be the new Sports Pavilion, but not very central, Harrisons Store would be best place but lots of conditions. To approach AH and go from there. To update at next meeting.
- f) Donations – Carnival Committee asking for £1000 again this year, MH proposed and MM seconded.
- g) Quarry – meeting at Westnewton, Tony Markley was in attendance. Wagons speeding which the villagers had concerns about. Not much to report, other than Armstrongs wagons go one way and Harrisons go the other.
- h) Flowers – MM cannot do the flowers this year after having cataract operation and due to have another op later on in the year. Need someone to take over this job for this year and hopefully MM will be ok for next year. Get Bill Angel to get plants etc again and maybe get the youth Club involved if MM supervised. Last weekend in May to put plants in.
- i) Highways – Tony reported that work will start next week on Rumbling Bridge. Other works have already been done for example on Abbey Road.
